2014 ASHLAND SUMMER READING PROGRAM INSTRUCTION SHEET

VERY IMPORTANT: The Summer Reading Program begins on Thursday June 19 and ends on Tuesday September 2. DO NOT start tracking your reading before June 19. Please review these instructions VERY carefully.

IMPORTANT: READ PAGE 6 of this flyer for additional information as you track your reading.

If you track your reading **ONLINE**, please go to www.readsinma.org/index.asp?lib=ashland and follow the instructions on the site. You **MUST** re-register online with a new ID and password, even if you registered in previous years.

If you track your reading **ON PAPER, YOU MUST WRITE VERY NEATLY AND CLEARLY. PARENTS** - please check your child's reading log to make certain that every entry is **CLEAR AND EASY TO READ.**

You can track your reading by **books/chapters** **OR** by **hours/minutes**, but **NOT** both. Pick a format and use that method all summer. Please try to read books that are **appropriate** for your reading level.

If you are tracking your reading by **books/chapters**, please remember:

- Picture books are considered **ONE** book/chapter.
- Write the **name** of the book and the **author** on the line
- If books do not have regularly marked chapters, like the *Diary of a Wimpy Kid* series or the *Geronimo Stilton* series, **count every 10 pages as ONE** chapter.
- Magazines like *Sports Illustrated for Kids* or *National Geographic for Kids* should be counted as **THREE** chapters.
- Audio books should be counted as if you read the book. For example, if you listen to one of the *Harry Potter* audio books, and the book has 25 chapters, then count the audio book as 25 chapters.
- If you are reading a book with many chapters, please write the name of the book and the **total number of chapters** on the log **just ONE time**. No need to re-write the name of the book each time.
- You may read the same book more than once and count it each time.

If you are tracking your reading by **hours/minutes**, please remember:

- You must total **each WEEK'S minutes** on the form. That will make it easier to total the amount of minutes and hours for the entire summer.

YOU MUST LIVE IN ASHLAND in order to participate in this reading program.

All Reading Logs must be completed and handed into your new classroom teacher **NO LATER THAN WEDNESDAY SEPTEMBER 3. This is a firm date.**

YOU MUST RETURN ALL FORMS IN A LONG WHITE ENVELOPE CLEARLY MARKED WITH YOUR NAME, GRADE, TEACHER NAME, PHONE NUMBER AND EMAIL ADDRESS. DO NOT SEAL THE ENVELOPE.

If you are home-schooled or if you attend a charter, private, religious or other type of school, please return your forms to the **Ashland Public Library by Wednesday September 3.**
